## APPENDIX for Derby Township History Histories of Families on Century Farms

**NOTE:** The names of the generations on the farm are in **bold** print. The families are listed according to the order in Chapter 9 Century Farms pgs. 187-229

### **Coulter Century Farm & Family History**

**185-188**

**Hugh Coulter**, (?-1859) his wife **Janet ?**, and three children left New Daley, Ayrshire, Scotland, move to Canada. They first lived on the Humber River, County of York, Toronto. They came to Grey County in September, 1847. The Coulters had ten children: Thomas and Sarah, both born and died in infancy in Scotland; William, died at age 2 years; **Robert D.**; Elizabeth; Alexander; Margaret; Janet; **Hugh** and Mary. **Robert D.** inherited the family farm, sold it to his brother **Hugh**, and moved to Manitoba in 1882. **Hugh** married **Jane Porteous** and they had five children: William, **Edward**, Elizabeth, Rachel, and Janet. **Edward** married Marie Louise Miscampbell and their son **John** married **Jessie Weaver**. John and Jessie had four children: **Frank**, Shirley (Mrs. Carl Spencer), Linda (Mrs. D. Scott) and Jane. **Frank** married **Sharon Lemon** and had two sons, **Edward and Christopher**. Frank managed C.I.L. Agromart in Tara. The Coulter family farm is named **Sprucedale** and, as of 1972, they are the sixth generation of Coulters to live on this century farm. For more details, read pages 185 to 188 in the Derby Township History book.

### **Cunningham Century Farm & Family History**

**188-190**

**John Cunningham** (?-1903) married **Elizabeth McKerroll** (-1880) Both were from Beith, Ayrshire, Scotland. John came to Canada first and then sent for Elizabeth and their three children: **Fulton**, Mary (Mrs. John Hall) and Jessie (Mrs. James Lyons). They came to Canada and moved to Derby township about 1864. John and Elizabeth had seven more children, born in Canada: Elizabeth (Mrs. Charles Wilson); John; Margaret (Mrs. David Douglas). Archibald, Robert, Alexander, and Daniel. **Fulton** (?-1929) married **Adelaide Reid** (?-1905) and they had four children: **Fulton Jr.** ; Isabel; Adelaide; and Grace. The two youngest daughters died in infancy. The Cunningham Farm is named **Mt. Pleasant**. Read pages 188-190 for more details about the Cunningham family farm.

### **Garvie Century Farm and Family History**

**190-193**

**Joseph Garvie** and his wife and four sons came to Canada from Bankfoot, Perthshire, Scotland. He bought two parcels of land, one in 1862 and the other in 1864. The four Garvie sons were **Alexander ("Sandy")**; John; William; and Joseph. **"Sandy"** and his

wife raised ten children – seven daughters and three sons: Anne, Liza; Mary; Sarah; Peter; Alice; **Walter**; Hannah; and Wilbur.

**Walter** married **Mary Robertson** and they had three children: **Thomas Alexander (Alex)**, Margaret Janet (Mrs. Mervin Johnson); and Walter Allan. **Alex** married **Ina Day** and they had three children: George Alexander; Donald Beverly; and Donna Sophia (Mrs. T. Kuhl). The Garvie Farm is named **Fairfield Farm** and, as of 1972, has been in the Garvie name for 110 years. Read more details in pages 190 to 193.

### **Hall Century Farm and Family History**

**194-196**

**John Hall** and his wife **Janet Hamilton** came to Canada from County Armagh, Ireland. He first lived in Pickering township, then Sullivan, then Derby. John and Janet had 12 children: Caroline (Mrs. James Atcheson); Emma Jane (Mrs. Duncan Sinclair), Elizabeth, Ellen (Mrs. Sam Stewart); John; Margaret; Minnie (Mrs. F. Proud); William; Alice; Etta; Lillie; and **James**.

**James** married **Elizabeth Henderson** and they had three children: Stuart; Kathleen (Mrs. George McLeod); and **Mac**. **Mac** married **Mary Kergan** and they have three children: **Larry**; and **Randy**. **Larry** and **Randy Hall** are the fifth generation of Halls to live on the farm. The Hall Farm is west of Keady and more details are found on pages 194 through 196.

### **Hamilton Century Farm and Family History**

**196-199**

Three Hamilton brothers – John, **Henry** (1820-1880) and Thomas came to Canada from County Mayo in about 1847. All three brothers settled in Sunny Valley, Derby township. **Henry** married **Ellen Hall** and they had a family of 16 children. Henry was killed when his horses ran away. **George** (1877-1941), the youngest son of Henry and Ellen Hamilton, took over the farm. **George** married **Agnes Bell** and they had four children: Ellen (Mrs. Frank Waterton); Mary (Mrs. Walter Hill); Agnes (Mrs. Robert Robertson); and **James Henry**. George died in a car accident in 1941.

**James** married **Anna Bumstead** had two children: **William James** and Jean (Mrs. Maurice Wilson). William J. married **Edna Laird** and, as of 1972, they have three children: Catherine, Ruth Ann and James William. **Update**: two more daughters were born to the Hamiltons: **Wilma** (Mrs. Jim Roney) and Mary Lou. Young Bill, the only son, was killed in an accident in 1999. **Wilma** and her family live on the family farm today. The Farm name is **Hilltop Clear**. More details about the Hamilton Family Farm are found in pages 196-199.

### **Brown-Leask Century Farm and Family History**

**199-201**

**Duncan Brown** and his wife and six children came to Canada from Dunbartonshire, Islay, Scotland, and were among the first settlers in Derby township. The six children were:

**Mary (Mrs. David Leask);** Catherine (Mrs. Archibald Brown); Miriam (Mrs, John Perkins); Duncan; Donald; and a youngest son who died on the ocean voyage over from Scotland. The youngest child, Mary Ann (Mrs. George Hooper).

**Mary and her husband David Leask** inherited the farm, along with her brother **Duncan Brown**. Mary and David's son **John Leask** married **Charlotte G. Civil**, and they had six children: Charlotte (Mrs, Ivy Walter); Mary (Mrs. Andrew Beattie); Welda; Marian (Mrs. Harold Leahy); **Clifford**; and Robert. Mary Leask and Duncan Brown gave the farm to **John Leask**

When **John Leask** died, the farm was given to **Clifford**. As of 1972, he was the fourth generation to live on the farm. The farm was named **Twin Maple Farm**. For more details, read pages 199-201.

### **Mitchell-MacDonald Century Farm and Family History      201=203**

**Francis Mitchell** (1834-), the son of Mr. and Mrs. Alexander Mitchell was from Fyvie, Aberdeenshire, Scotland. Francis married Barbara Gray and they moved to Canada in 1854, along with baby George Mitchell. The family was originally planning to move to Australia, but the fare to Canada was cheaper than a fare to Australia. A stone mason, **Francis** worked on the Owen Sound jail, Buchan House and other stone buildings. Francis' brother William moved to Derby also, along with his wife Margaret Gray, sister of Francis' wife Barbara Gray.

**Francis and Barbara** had a son **George** and a daughter (Mrs. John Young). George Mitchell had two daughters: **Barbara (Mrs. Sam Coleman)** and Christina (Mrs. James Aickin). Barbara and Sam Coleman had three children:

Gordon Mitchell, James McCurdy and Jean Isabell. The Coleman family sold the farm to Mr. and Mrs. Donald MacDonald. Mrs. Betty Coleman MacDonald was the 2x great granddaughter of Frank Mitchell. As of 1972, they are the sixth generation to live on the farm. For more details, read pages 201 to 203.

### **McInnis Century Farm and Family History**

**203-207**

**Mrs. Margaret McMillan McInnis**, a widow, moved to Canada from Scotland, to escape the religious persecution of the Presbyterians by the English. She brought her family of eight children with her: William, James, John, Jesse, **Israel**, Thomas, Mary Jane and Johanna. John McInnis (1799-?) came first to Canada to find land for the family about 1826 to 1828. The McInnis, Hall, and Barber families travelled together from Scotland. Once in Ontario, the group came up the Garafraxa Road to Sydenham Village (Owen Sound). **Israel McInnis** settled in Derby; William at Arnott. James near Keady; and the others in various other locations.

Mrs. Margaret McInnis, the mother lived her sons with Jesse and Israel. **Israel McInnis** married **Mary Ann Hall**, from Antrim, Ireland, and they had nine children, six sons and three daughters. The oldest son, **William**, took over the farm when his father Israel was thrown from a horse and died in 1860.

**William McInnis** married **Agnes Hardie** and they had one son and six daughters. **Israel**, their only son, married Alma ? **Israel** and Agnes had several children not listed. Their

son, **Israel**, married **Helen Beatty** of Inglis Falls and they had three children: Dorothea (Mrs. Elwyn McInnis); Agnes (Mrs. John Ferguson) and **William B.** There were five generations of the McInnis family to live on the farm before it was sold in 1960 to Roy and Barb Lunau. For more details, see pages 203 to 207.

### **Moore Century Farm and Family History**

**207-208**

**Robert Moore** married **Anne Patterson** in the north part of Ireland and they moved to Canada and purchased land in 1864. They had three children: Margaret (Mrs. Andrew Garvie); Mary; and **Thomas John**. Thomas married **Anne Belles Abra** and they had one son, **Elwood McKinley Moore**. **Elwood** married **Rosalie McConnell** and they have one son Brian. They are the four generations that have lived on the Moore Century farm. See pages 207-208.

### **Mundle-Holding Century Farm and Family History**

**209-211**

**William Mundle** of Smith's Falls, Ontario, purchased a farm from John Gray. William's son **Robert S. Mundle** married **Mary Elizabeth Lauder** in 1875. They had six sons and three daughters. The second eldest son **Robert S. Mundle Jr.** took over the farm and in 1916 married **Emma Miskie**. They had two children: Robert R. and **Myrtle**. Myrtle married **Harold Holding**. **Myrtle** and **Harold** have two children: Lorraine and **Allen**. **Allen Holding** took over the farm from his father Harold. More details are found on pages 209-211.

### **Fleming-Mundle Century Farm and Family History**

**211-212**

**Alexander Fleming** bought land from the Crown in 1851. He had two sons: **Alexander Fleming II** and William Fleming. **Alexander II** married and had two sons: Joseph Fleming and **Albert Fleming**. The two brothers shared the farm for a time, and later divided the property between them. **Albert** married **Christina Morrison**. **Christina** was one of two survivors of the sinking of the steamship Asia in Georgian Bay in 1882. They had one son, **Clifford**. **Clifford Fleming** married **Verda** ? and they had two children: **Stanley** and Katherine. Stanley sold the farm to Leonard Mundle in 1966. The farm had been named **Sylvan Shade Farm**, due to the number of shade trees that have since been cut down. Read more about the Fleming-Mundle farm on pages 211-212.

### **Munson Century Farm and Family History**

**213**

**William Mundle Sr.** and his brother and cousin moved to Canada from Ireland. **William** bought a farm from a Mr. Coventry. **William Sr.** had a son **William**, who took over the farm and lived there until he sold it to his younger brother **George Mundle**. George's son **Harold Mundle** inherited the farm. Harold married **Betty Bradshaw** in 1950 and they

had four children: Douglas, Thomas, Alison and Kenneth. They were the fifth generation to live on the farm. It was named **Elmtri Farm**. More details can be found on page 213.

### **Ormandy Century Farm and Family History**

**214-215**

**William Ormandy**, his wife and children came to Derby township from England in 1858. They had eleven children. Their oldest daughter Mary was two years old and came with her parents. Mr. William Ormandy was a weaver and worked for Harrison Woollen Mills and farmed his land. One of William's granddaughters, **Bessie Randle Davidson**, the wife of **George Davidson** lived on the family farm in 1972. The farm home was named

**Tranquility** by Bessie Davidson. More details are found on pages 214 to 215.

### **James Porteous Century Farm and Family History**

**215-220**

**Edward Porteous** was born in Ireland in 1800. His widow and six children came to Canada in 1841. The children were: Simon, James, Jane, Catherine, Ann and Thomas. Simon and James leased a portion of the Coulter property until 1866. The farm that James bought was inherited by **Edward J. Porteous**, nephew of James. **Edward J. Porteous** married **Mary Louise Dodds** and had four children: James, **Victor**, Myra and Kathleen. **Victor C.** married **Alma Mary Wilson** and they had four children: Leola Florence, Edward McKinley, **Elwin James (Jim)**, and Alma Victoria. Jim Porteous took over the farm and Victor Porteous was elected as Member of Parliament for North Grey 1930 to 1935. **Jim Porteous** married **Mary MacDonald** and they have five children: Susan; Sherrie Lou ;James Jr.; Nancy; and Mary Ann. They five children were the fifth generation to live on the farm. More about the Porteous family and farm is found in pages 215 to 220.

### **Wyllie Century Farm and Family History**

**220-224**

The **Victor Wyllie** farm was originally owned by **Alexander Fleming** who bought it in 1847. One of Alexander Fleming's sons, **James Fleming**, married Grace Robertson and they had eleven children. James Fleming's daughter **Mary Fleming** married **George Wyllie** and they had five children. Their son **Victor Wyllie** married **Marion Fields** and they had three sons: George, Douglas and Robert. The Wyllie home caught fire in 1853 and only the stone walls were left. The farm was named **Forestlawn Farm**. Read family stories and anecdotes about the Wyllie family and farm on pages 220 through 224.

### **Smith Century Farm and Family History**

**224-225**

**Alexander Smith** married **Ann Canmore** in Antrim, Ireland and they came to Derby township about 1850. They had five children: Mary; Alex; **James Canmore**; William



John; and Alice (Mrs. W. Osborne). James Canmore Smith lived on the family farm his whole life. **James C.** married **Margaret McArthur**. They had four children: Mary Lena (Mrs. Saul Reiley); Alice; Kathleen; and **D. A, Smith**. **D. A,** married **Eva Carson** and they had two sons Wayne and Brian. The farm was sold to Kenneth Beckett in 1958. Read the entire history on pages 224 to 225.

### **Young Century Farm and Family History**

**225-226**

**James Young** married **Mary Harkness** in Roxboroughshire, Scotland in 1844. They came to Derby township on 1853. They had six children, two sons and four daughters. The elder son, **John Young** took over the farm and married **Isabel Catherine Mitchell**. John died when his son James Francis was a few months old. Mrs. Young's father, Francis Mitchell, a Derby pioneer, operated the farm until **James Francis** was old enough to take over. **James F.** married **Margaret McClelland** in 1936 and died in 1955. See pages 225-226 for the whole story.

### **Alexander Fleming Century Farm and Family History**

**227-229**

**Alexander Fleming** came to Canada from Scotland with his wife and eight children in 1845. The family first lived in Vaughan township but moved north to Derby in 1847-1849. Their son **Alexander II** (1832-1897). He took over the farm in 1855 and married **Ann Garvie**. They had ten children: William; Alexander; John; Joseph; Albert; Jessie; Margaret; David; Bertha; and **Ernest**. **Ernest**, the youngest son, took over the farm in 1903. He married **Margaret Pike**. They had four children: Clare; Karl; Melville; and Marjorie (Mrs. C. Sutcliffe). The farm was named **Maple Lane Farm** owing to the long lane of maple trees. The farm was sold to Leonard Mundle in 1966. The rest of the history is found on pages 227 to 229.
