

INDEX for Township of Proton – A Historical Sketch 1857 – 1982

NOTES:

The first two pages in the History Book of Proton Township have no number, so I have called them the "introduction pages" (intro.).

There is a variation in spelling throughout the book, for example McDonald vs. MacDonald, e.g. Therefore I have listed both names. Please check both.

Last names preceded by Miss or Mr. generally refer to teachers. However, some of the masculine last names with the prefix Mr. refer to ministerial students serving as pulpit supply for Proton church services.

Due to the Scots-Irish tradition of repeating first names, there may be two or more individuals under the same name, e.g. Thomas/Tom Smith. Married women are listed under their husband's name with their maiden/full name in parenthesis following entry.
